Recall and Reminder Systems

Help to access PIP and SIP

The project officer from CSDGP can visit your practice to evaluate the best system for your individual practice. Effective paper-based systems may be implemented or alternatively software training is available for those that are computerised.

The Division provides Medical Director training for Recall and Reminder that can be used not only for Cervical Screening, but across your Practice. Training in the use of Medical Director clinical software to generate recall and reminder data and correspondence. Contact the Division on 9799 0933.

GP and Practice Staff Education and Training

The project officer from CSDGP can visit your practice to discuss practice systems and processes and how these can be used effectively to recruit women for Pap smears. Training can also be provided for GPs and practice staff in establishing electronic reminders and using a computerised recall system through your clinical software program, to ensure that women are returning for their Pap smear at the required interval. GP Cervical Screening Upskilling Workshop

The NSW Cervical Screening Program has funded FPA Health to conduct a series of 2-hour workshops. Participation is free of charge and participants will receive CME points.
